

2024 Association Highlights



Association

Raised \$2.4 million through the Annual Campaign, special events, and donations to support children, families, and adults participating in YMCA programs.

Secured \$1.3 million in grant support.

Raised over \$180,000 at the 23rd annual Kids to Camp Golf Tournament, presented by Coca-Cola Beverages Northeast, in support of summer camp scholarships.

Piloted youth program bundling at the Hale Family YMCA and Wilson-Gray YMCA Youth and Family Center, which included parent/child swim lessons as part of family memberships.

Hosted an association-wide Healthy Kids Day at Dunkin' Park.

Launched the GHYMCA
Leadership Lab, with six
participants graduating in the
inaugural class. Their capstone
project led to the creation
of a Diaper Bank at the East
Hartford YMCA Larson Center.

Served 230 youth in the BellXcel summer learning and enrichment program, where participants gained an average of 1.0 months in literacy skills and 1.5 months in math skills.

YMCA Camp Woodstock

Exceeded Annual Campaign goal and raised over \$130,000 that allowed 132 children to experience summer camp.

Received \$100,000 matching fund grant from YMCA of the USA bringing our overall Capital Campaign to \$1.42M, 113% of goal.

Partnered with The Arc, a nonprofit dedicated to supporting individuals with Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities (IDD), to offer summer camp parents the opportunity to purchase cookies for delivery to their child's cabin. This initiative provides campers with a taste of home as well as creates employment opportunities for individuals with IDD.

Raised \$8,000 to send six
Camp Woodstock counselors
and two advisory council
members to underserved
communities in the Dominican
Republic, where they helped
build a home for a single
mother and her children.



Camp Jewell YMCA

Served 1,789 campers through our day and overnight camp programs.

Raised \$292,140 through donations and grants to provide over 200 scholarships with the help of 323 donors.

Provided one free week of day camp for every student enrolled in the Colebrook Consolidated Elementary School through the support of local donors.

Completed a slingshot range that was built by a camper as part of her Girl Scout Gold award.

Recycled over 23,000 pounds of food through our new composting program and eliminated 23,728 bottles and cans through our new Juice Jam program.

Served campers from 412 towns, 39 states and 8 countries in our summer programs.

Downtown YMCA

Raised \$19,000 through the Annual Campaign to support affordable memberships and enhance community health initiatives. Strengthened our commitment to drowning prevention awareness by increasing participation in youth swim lessons. This was accomplished through our partnership with the City of Hartford and Mayor Arulampalam, ensuring more Hartford children have access to life-saving skills. 100 families participated in the program.

Celebrated the Downtown YMCA's impact through our Mission in Motion event, which raised \$23,000, reinforcing our mission of accessible health and wellness for all.

East Hartford YMCA

Hosted a successful back-toschool cookout and fall open house, where we engaged families and community partners in early learning and afterschool programs.

Through our partnership with Early Start CT, 54 children received financial support, ensuring access to high-quality early education.

Raised \$23,000 through the Annual Campaign to provide financial assistance for families in child development programs in our Early Learning Centers.





Farmington Valley YMCA

Hosted Bike for the Battle and the Granby Road Race, engaging over 428 participants and raising \$68,649 to support LIVE**STRONG**® at the YMCA cancer survivor program.

Delivered water safety education to over 2,000 students across five schools in three towns, promoting safer summer experiences.

Provided free swimming lessons during Safety Around Water week in partnership with the Wilson-Gray YMCA Youth and Family Center, serving 44 children and adults.

Offered parent-child, preschool, and youth swim lessons to 1,003 participants, fostering essential water safety skills. Enhanced the branch with a new challenge course, thanks to the generosity of Squadron Capital, expanding day camp activities and youth development programs.

Hosted two drug- and alcohol-free post-graduation celebrations, providing a safe space for over 325 high school graduates to celebrate their achievements.

Welcomed Ranjeet Singh from the Granite YMCA as he completed the Hartford Marathon—the 38th marathon in his inspiring journey to run a marathon in all 50 states.

Surpassed 235,000 visits to our YMCA in 2024!

Glastonbury and Tri-Town YMCAs

Received funding to pilot BellXcel summer camp program in Wethersfield for summer 2025.

Hosted the inaugural Color Run in partnership with East Harford YMCA with over 100 children from Glastonbury, Wethersfield, and East Hartford.





Hale YMCA Youth and Family Center

Opened a new licensed schoolage childcare site at Pomfret Community School, serving 25 children.

Relaunched Middle School Night Out, free for 5th-8th grade students, with 120 youth attending nine events.

Launched a Mental Health and Wellness Task Force to tackle the increasing mental health needs in our community, which brought new programs like the Community Strides Family Running program, Screenagers, and A Walk in Her Shoes.

Exceeded our Annual Campaign goal of \$95,000 by raising \$103,500, which provided membership, program, and camp support, allowing 730 individuals access to the Y to lead healthier lives and create lasting memories.

Exceeded our Road to Wellness goal of \$35,000 and raised \$43,000 to support chronic disease prevention programs like Enhance Fitness and LIVESTRONG® at the YMCA cancer survivor program, helping 50 people in our most vulnerable population on their journey to better health.

Indian Valley Family YMCA

Graduated 51 cancer survivors from LIVE**STRONG**® at the YMCA cancer survivor program, thanks to Platinum-level support from Earthlight Technologies, USA Waste & Recycling, and L.L. Bean.

Delivered the BellXcel summer learning and enrichment program in partnership with the Vernon Public School system, serving 22 youth entering 5th and 6th grade.

Provided \$22,363 in financial assistance, enabling 37 youth to attend Camp Indian Valley.

Served 25,892 meals and provided care for 349 children through our child development programs.

Hosted two blood drives in partnership with the American Red Cross and a flu vaccine clinic, administering 64 flu immunizations.

Collected over 15 totes of food and hygiene products for local food banks.

Hosted the 7th Annual Spirits for Giving Gala, raising \$28,610.

Exceeded the Annual Campaign goal by raising \$87,442.

Celebrated the Indian Valley Breakers Swim Team's first YMCA national champion in the mile swim.

West Hartford YMCA

Received \$9,500 from proceeds raised at the Old Guard annual golf tournament to help support the BellXcel summer learning and enrichment programs.

Achieved Annual Campaign goal of \$40,000.

Participated in West Hartford community events such as Celebrate West Hartford and partnered with the West Hartford Public Library to offer free events to children and families.

Graduated 27 school-age children from the BellXcel program.





Wheeler Regional Family YMCA

Received a \$5,000 grant from the Community Foundation of Greater New Britain and a \$1,000 grant from the Main Street Community Foundation to help support the purchase of Adaptive Fitness equipment.

Collected 90 pounds of food during the holiday season to help support the Plainville Food pantry. Partnered with the American Red Cross to be a host site for local blood drives throughout the year, collecting a total of 30 pints of blood.

Received a \$9,300 grant from the McPhee Foundation in support of purchasing new AED equipment, and upgraded AED and CPR training supplies.

Celebrated the graduation of 10 children from our preschool program.

Wilson-Gray YMCA Youth and Family Center

Partnered with the American Red Cross and the New England Sickle Cell Institute of UConn Health to host the annual Juneteenth Sickle Cell Awareness Blood Drive. The event exceeded the donor goal of 50+ with a total of 62 attendees donating blood.

Collaborated with The Reach Foundation to host a free back-to-school kickoff event for over 250 community members, where students received free hair braiding, haircuts, and backpacks filled with elementary, middle, and high school supplies.

Hosted annual sit-down and to-go Thanksgiving meals to over 350 people in partnership with For the Community by the Community.

Secured a \$136,000 grant from Inspire and the Justice Education Center to partner with Active City in forming the Hartford Girls Sports Club (HGSC). This partnership funds the Girls Creating a Future group and girls basketball program. All those participating in HGSC receive a free YMCA membership.

Opened the Early Learning Center with the capacity to serve up to 44 children, from infancy to age 5.



Robert C. Knox, Jr. YMCA Distinguished Leadership Award

At the heart of the YMCA of Greater Hartford are many individuals who embody the spirit of giving and the power of community.

Annette R. Larabee, this year's recipient of the Robert C. Knox, Jr. YMCA Distinguished Leadership Award, is one of them. Throughout her career, both professionally and through her involvement with the Y, Annette has remained dedicated to fostering connections and making a positive impact on those around her.

For Annette, community isn't just a concept—it's a way of life. Since becoming involved with the Glastonbury branch in 2008, Annette has embraced opportunities to help the Y grow and thrive. As a member of the board of trustees and finance committee, she continues to lead with a passion for bringing people together and creating opportunities for growth.

"Giving back to the community has always been important to me," Annette shares.

"The Y is a vital part of our region, and I've always tried to do my part to keep it relevant and strong."

Her commitment to the YMCA's mission is evident in the many roles she has taken on, from serving on the Glastonbury YMCA Board of Advisors to chairing the Association's finance committee, serving as Association board treasurer, and participating on the audit and real estate committees. Most recently, she chaired the search committee for the incoming President and Chief Executive Officer.

Annette's expertise as a financial executive and her natural talent for building relationships have made her a highly respected and influential leader within the YMCA of Greater Hartford. Among the numerous programs the YMCA of Greater Hartford has championed, two stand out as her personal favorites: the BellXcel summer learning and enrichment program and the Wilson-Gray YMCA Best Buy Teen Tech Center. Both initiatives reflect her dedication to empowering youth and fostering lifelong skills.

"I love working on programs like these," Annette explains. "More than anything else, it's the people involved that keep me so connected. Seeing young people learn and grow is what truly inspires me."

Annette's own journey to community service was shaped by her upbringing. As the daughter of a military family, she moved frequently and longed for a place to call home. She and her husband found that sense of belonging in Glastonbury, where they have lived for many years. Their three sons, who benefited from the Y's afterschool programs and youth sports programs like ski club, are now grown and actively involved in community efforts themselves—a legacy of giving that Annette and her husband have clearly passed on. Outside of her work with the YMCA, Annette has built a successful career in finance, spending over 25 years as a senior manager at regional banks.

Her strengths lie in fostering productive connections and making sound business decisions, skills that have naturally extended to her volunteer work. She is passionate about financial literacy and has dedicated time to educating others through organizations like Junior Achievement, the Hispanic Health Center, the Connecticut River Valley Chamber of Commerce, and the Glastonbury Town Center Initiative.

Her educational background from Bryant University, where she earned a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration and Business Communications, laid the foundation for her expertise in finance, real estate investing, and business ownership. Yet, despite her professional success, it's her unwavering dedication to community that truly sets her apart.

Reflecting on her journey, Annette expresses gratitude for the community she serves. "I feel blessed to live in such a vibrant and giving community and to have the ability to help others whenever I can," she says.
